22% of workers in food preparation and servingrelated jobs live in food insecure households.





Warehouse workers often work for temp agencies for piece rate that doesn't add up to minimum wage or overtime pay.



23% of grocery store workers are paid less than the minimum wage, and 65% aren't paid overtime.

7 of the 10 worst-paying jobs in the U.S. are in our food system, and food workers face some of the most difficult and dangerous working conditions.
